SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES 2026
\$4,000

1. Any student may apply for this scholarship, which is not limited in any way by sex, race, religion, national origin, creed or color.
2. Scholarships are limited to tax-supported public institutions of higher education, trade schools, and trade programs in the state of Oregon.
3. Preferred: 3.0 to 3.5 grade point average.
4. The applicant must be a good student who is prompt with assigned tasks and shows promise of completing at least two years of a specific educational program.
5. Applications must be printed and handed in to Lori Sauter in the College and Career Center by **April 8, 2026**. (Letters of recommendation should be printed, signed, and delivered to Lori by the recommender, not the applicant, by this date. To allow recommenders to be completely honest, students shouldn't read their letters.)
6. All requested documentation must be provided to be considered: (a) autobiography, (b) transcripts, (c) 3 reference letters, and (d) SAI from either the FAFSA Submission Summary or final page of the submitted ORSAA.
7. Applications will be screened, and ALL eligible applications will be sent to the Eugene Masonic Lodge #11 Scholarship Committee.
8. The Lodge scholarship committee will select winners in early May 2026 for both scholastic and trade programs.
9. Scholarships will be presented on May 20th at a dinner banquet hosted by Eugene Masonic Lodge #11 at the Lodge building. **Do not apply for this scholarship unless you're available to attend.**
