

Using the Take Tech quiz in your classroom :)

The Quiz will take no longer than 10 minutes to complete. Once the quiz is completed you can go back to the Elementary Students tab and click on any (or all!) of the posters to get more information about each course.

1. Open the TAKE TECH website to the TAKE TECH quiz, it's at the bottom of the Elementary Students tab
2. Ask the student(s) to have a pen/pencil and the TAKE TECH handout ready to record their answers. (Below is a Take Tech quiz handout!)
3. Read through each of the 5 questions and have the students record the answer best suited to them--and they can only choose one!
4. Once the students have answered the questions it's time to turn their answers into colours by following the chart on the quiz. For example, if you answered D to question 1 the colour you would record is purple.
5. The colour the student has the most of is the colour that represents their best suited Tech Education course.
6. Teachers can take the students back to the Elementary Student tab on the website to click on the Tech Education posters. Those posters are links to more information. (This may take an additional 10-20 minutes, depending on if its student or teacher lead.) The teacher may want to read aloud all 10 Tech Education course descriptions.
7. If teachers receive questions about tech courses they can send them to octehumanresources@octe.ca or check their local high school website for the Tech Ed Department head's email.
