Workshops can be tailored to suit the needs of the group or to tie in with a production or area of study.

Workshops can include:

- Basic principles of puppetry (breath, weight, focus etc.).
- Different forms of puppetry, such as shadow puppetry, table top puppets and marionettes.
- Making puppets from recycled materials.
- Making puppets from household objects.
- Puppet design and prototyping.
- Writing for puppetry.
- Devising and improvising with puppets.
- Bringing puppets into a show alongside a human cast.

Past Experience

- **2019 Real Ideas Workshops.** Puppet making and puppetry performance workshops for SEN teenagers and young adults. The workshops consisted of performance techniques, puppet making, devising with puppets and adding music to a performance.
- **2019 The Shearing Gang.** Working in collaboration with Dogwood Productions' show. Puppetry building and performance workshop with KS2 children in schools and community spaces. The workshops involved a building and puppetry workshop leading to short performance.
- **2021 Pinocchio.** A Norwich Puppet Theatre production touring to children's theatres, community spaces and schools.
- **2022 When Seagulls Saved the World.** Outdoor theatre production with workshops alongside. The set up varied from puppet making workshops in community space to making and performance workshops for Cornwall Neighbourhood For Change.
- **2022 Another Winter's Tale.** Workshops in storytelling for KS2 alongside a touring theatre production. Exploring different techniques including shadow puppetry, kamishibai and music to create short performances.
- **2024 Facing the Waves.** Reminiscence recordings and workshops with community groups and individuals across North Yorkshire and Teesside.
- **2025/26 Open Doors: Artist in Residence** at The National Civil War Centre, working with Newark and Sherwood District Council. Residency includes workshops and community projects in the county.
