Research Requests to Access D16 SASP Newsletter

This document is meant to address how to handle requests to disseminate research via the D16 SASP monthly newsletter or listserve. Requests must meet these criteria and may be subject to further questioning or clarifications by the board:

- 1. Aligned with goals of division (e.g., contribute to mission and/or current initiatives)
- 2. Contributes to knowledge in school psychology, with an emphasis on benefits for graduate students and working towards social justice in the field. Why should this research be disseminated through SASP communications?
- 3. Proof of IRB approval and approval by faculty advisor for students.
- 4. Full SASP Board approval of data collection tools and recruitment email. The SASP board may have follow-up questions before approval.
- 5. Dissemination of findings to SASP Board and to the school psychology community through one of the following methods:
 - Submission of manuscript to The Student Corner within 2 years of this approval
 - o Contacts: SASP Editor, Editor-Elect
 - Provide link to abstract, poster, or other means of dissemination for inclusion in our newsletter
 - o Contacts: SASP Communications Liaison
 - Provide infographic of study for dissemination in SASP monthly newsletter
 - o Contacts: SASP Editor, Editor-Elect, Communications Liaison
 - Other method of intended dissemination approved by board on case-by-base basis
