



Amended Congressional Map Analysis Toplines

Compared to the 2010 Congressional map, the newly amended 2022 Congressional map moves the Manchester suburbs of Hooksett and Merrimack, as well as Campton from Grafton County and the majority of Carroll County including Conway from CD1 to CD2. The Republican leaning towns of Loudon and Pittsfield from Merrimack County, as well as Deerfield, Northwood, Salem, Windham, and Atkinson are moved from Rockingham county are moved from CD2 to CD1.

While making CD1 slightly more Republican leaning, it remains a tossup district. CD2 remains a lean Democratic district. Measured in terms of the 2020 federal election, CD1 goes from a +6 Biden district to a +4 Biden district under this map. CD2 changes to a Biden +10 from a Biden +9.

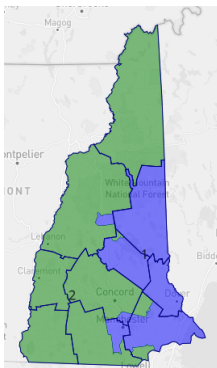
At the Congressional level, Democratic candidates in the newly amended 2022 CD1 received a combined 52%, compared to the 52% Congressman Pappas received in 2020. Democratic candidates in the proposed CD2 received 56%, compared to the 55% Congresswoman Kuster received in 2020.

CD2 now contains the vast majority of the North Country, where before it was split into two districts. CD1 now contains the entirety of Rockingham County, while losing some Manchester suburbs. The Governor's proposal moves 152,537 people between districts, compared to 364,703 people displaced from the Legislature's proposal. The deviation of the House's new proposal is 0.2% or 1,431 people, compared to 2.6% for the current maps, or 0.02% for the Legislature passed proposal.

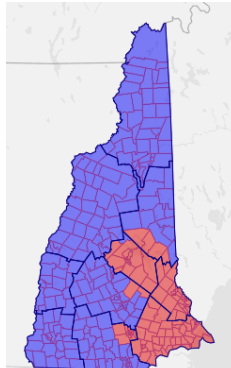
While the 2010 maps had a balanced amount of registered Republicans and Democrats (31% each), this proposal moves slightly more registered Republicans into CD1. This leaves the district with 32% Republicans but only 31% Democrats. Meanwhile, in CD2 the new registered voter breakdown is 32% Democrat versus 28% Republican compared to 32% Democrat and 29% Republican in the previous maps.

Compared to the proposed Congressional Map that passed the Legislature, The newly amended Congressional proposal has CD1 at a +4 Biden district instead of a +2 Trump district. CD2 is now proposed as a Biden +10 district as opposed to a Biden +17 district.
