 6. Search in other recommended databases (if needed) Databases & Clinical Tools: UpToDate, Pubmed@USC, Drug Monographs 	
 7. Search in Articles & Websites listed on case guide and/or find & evaluate online sources (if needed) Articles & Websites: use list of trusted articles/websites from the guide before searching the internet; suggested articles and websites vary by case
