

Signed HTTP Exchanges: Origin Trial Feedback

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Origin Trials Settings and Stats

An Origin Trial started in Chrome M71 and is scheduled to end in Chrome M72. We had 26 sign-ups from 21 individual entities including AMP, Baidu Search, Protocol Labs and many others as of writing.

Feedback and Reactions

- [AMP](#) and Google Search built a developer preview site at g.co/webpackagepreview for a live demo at Chrome Dev Summit (CDS) held in Nov 2018.
UPDATE (Jan 26): AMP team also gave [very detailed feedback](#) for the feature, including their thinking about the tradeoffs, impact on content repudiability etc.
- Cloudflare built [support for Signed Exchange](#) and actively investing in it for a future milestone.
- AMP partners interested and experimenting, e.g. 1-800 flowers actually published pages in Signed Exchanges and co-demonstrated the live demo at CDS.
- DigiCert built [support for Signed Exchange Certificates](#).
- Protocol Labs [experimenting with Signed Exchange](#) on top of IPFS, gave [a quick feedback](#) that they are excited about the feature.

So far the feedback has been generally positive, while some mentioned that the process to generate exchanges is not very easy. We plan to continue working on a better adoption story to address this.
