#### **COVID-19 ISOLATION, TEST-TO-STAY AND QUARANTINE GUIDELINES**

#### What to do when your student is confirmed positive for Covid-19:

If your student is:	Then your student will:
COVID-19 Positive (regardless of vaccination status)	After 5 days, return to school wearing a well-fitted mask for additional 5 days

# What to do when your student has been identified as a close contact after exposure to a confirmed positive COVID-19 case:

Test-to-Stay (Option 1)		
<b>Test-to-Stay:</b> Students identified as a close contact after exposure to a confirmed positive COVID-19 case have the option to test throughout their quarantine period and remain in school		
If your student is:	Then your student will:	
Up-to-Date on COVID-19 vaccinations*	<ul> <li>Test negative on day 1 and monitor for symptoms for 10 days from last exposure</li> <li>If symptoms develop, wear a well-fitted mask for remaining 10 days</li> </ul>	
Unvaccinated or not up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccinations	<ul> <li>Test negative daily for 5 days and monitor for symptoms for 10 days from last exposure</li> <li>If symptoms develop, wear a well-fitted mask for remaining 10 days</li> <li>Complete 10-day quarantine at home if unable/unwilling to wear mask appropriately</li> </ul>	

Written results of your student's negative COVID-19 test must be provided if testing is not performed at school. Results must include your students name, birthdate and the date the test was obtained

Quarantine (Option 2)	
If your student is:	Then your student will:
Up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccinations*	<ul> <li>Wear a well-fitted mask for 5 days from last exposure</li> <li>If symptoms develop, wear well-fitted mask for remaining 10 days</li> </ul>
Unvaccinated or not up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccinations	<ul> <li>Quarantine at home for 5 days and monitor for symptoms for 10 days from last exposure</li> <li>If symptoms develop, must obtain negative test prior to returning to school or continue quarantine for full 10 days from last exposure</li> </ul>

### Symptoms to monitor for include:

- Fever and/or Chills
- Cough
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Nausea and/or Vomiting
- Shortness of breath

- Muscle or body aches New loss of smell or taste
- Sore Throat
- Congestion
- Runny nose
- Diarrhea
