

1. Regional Regent

- The Regional Regent is the Head of State of Asiana, an unelected position which by its actions represents the region itself, its existence, legitimacy, and unity; to be a source of clarification, voice of reason, and a representation of the spirit of Asiana.
 - Holding ultimate authority over foreign policy and defense of the region, while encouraging the growth of Asiana by advancing and advocating long term policies and legislation for its continuation.
 - Coordinating with foreign regions to establish embassies and close knit friendships and pacts for the defense and interest of Asiana.
 - Will maintain border security through control of the regional password and forming defensive forces when necessary.
 - In the event of a raid/invasion, the Regional Regent will retain the right to declare 'State of Emergency' which will suspend the Constitution and Laws of Asiana until the threat has been dealt with and Asiana has been liberated.
 - The Regent will oversee the execution of the law of the region, management of the regional map, the advancement of Asiana roleplay, conductions of polls and elections, updates of the world factbook, and running of recruitments drives/efforts all of which will be directly administered by the Government of Asiana Ministries.
 - Will retain the power to veto decisions made by the Government of Asiana.
 - The Regent however will respect the Government's and/or the General Assembly's overturns of vetoes by majority vote.
- Will appoint the Chancellor of the Region who will both craft and maintain the efficient running of the regional government on the behalf of the Regent.
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- Will acknowledge the election of the Prime Minister as the will of the members of the region.
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2. Chancellor of the Region

- Shall maintain the day to day operations of the government ministries, craft government policies for the continued well-being of the region, and enact the will of the Regional Regent when called for.

- Will be responsible for crafting and executing the laws and policies of the region
 - Maintaining the right to regularly review, edit, and/or propose laws and amendments that shall be for the good of the region as a whole.
 - Must acknowledge final decisions of regional referendums held against law changes.
 - Using regional laws and policies will act as an arbitrator to In-Character and Out-of-Character complaints and issues. Overseeing the Regional Message Board for roleplaying infractions and/or personal conflicts.
- While primarily responsible to the Regional Regent, the Chancellor will govern for the greater good of the region and shall maintain the right, with the support of the Prime Minister, to overrule policies and/or vetoes of the Regent.
- Will create and maintain government ministries that manage delegated responsibilities and duties to support the running of the region in various faculties. Supervising the conduct and activity of the directors to ensure effective management of their appointed offices.
 - Directors will be appointed by the Chancellor from approved pools of candidates crafted with the Prime Minister from the regional membership.
 - Before the institution of any new offices or editing the responsibilities/duties of the ministries the Chancellor of the Region must seek the support of the Prime Minister in doing so.
 - If the Chancellor fails to gain the support of the Prime Minister the proposed changes shall not go into effect.
 - The Chancellor of the Region will respect the ultimate consensus of the members of Asiana in regards to votes of no confidence against appointed directors by the General Assembly.
 - Should a vote pass to remove a director, the Chancellor will remove said director and appoint a new one from a new pool of candidates.
 - The Chancellor will consult with their Directors on requests and issues brought to them by members to come to a joint decision.
 - Recognizing that failing to respond to Director's reports within 48 hours will leave the final decision to the Director.
 - Should a Director fail to respond to member request within 48 hours it will fall to the Chancellor to make a final decision on the matter.

3. People's Prime Minister

- Shall be elected by a majority vote to represent and serve the interests of the members of Asiana directly in the regional government and act as a check to the Asiana Government and Regional Regent in the event of abuses.
 - Will be responsible for creating a pool of candidates with the Chancellor from which the Chancellor shall appoint Ministry Directors.
 - With the Chancellor, they will oversee the administrations of the directors over their ministries.
 - Their oversight of the directors shall be in the interest of the populace and shall receive complaints and issues from the general body in regards to the directors.
- It shall be the right of the Prime Minister, in their check against the government, to call for votes of no confidence against directors and even the Chancellor of the Region in the event of widespread dissatisfaction among regional members.
 - Should the Chancellor be deposed, the Prime Minister will act in their place until a new Chancellor is chosen by the Regional Regent.
- The Prime Minister, working with the Director of Constitutional and Roleplay Law, shall maintain open dialogue and forums with the general populace of the region so that members may express grievances with the government.
 - The Prime Minister will acknowledge the grievances and present them to the Chancellor of the Region and the Regional Regent so that they may acknowledge them and work with the Prime Minister to resolve them.

4. Director of Communications and Maps

- Responsible for the effective and timely maintenance of the regional map, regional world factbook, dispatches, and forums.
 - Shall receive and judge requests from players in regards to map related issues; including but not limited to expansion requests.
 - After consideration, the Director will report the request to the Chancellor along with their findings and opinions. The Chancellor and the Director will consult with each other to arrive to a final decision. The Director will then execute the request or provide the denial.
 - If the Chancellor fails to reply within 48 hours of receiving the report from the Director, it will fall to the Director to weigh and execute a final decision.
- Will be responsible for summarizing and reporting on the region's major role-playing events and the regional government's activities.

5. Director of Recruitment and Immigration

- Responsible for recruiting and attracting new and suitable nations to the region, welcoming new nations, and facilitating their assimilation into the region by providing necessary and appropriate tips and information.
 - Will coordinate with the Regional Regent and/or the Chancellor of the Region to safely receive the new players into the region through border defense measures.

6. Director of Research and Technology

- Responsible for receiving and judging player requests on technological progression. Shall determine plausibility via reasonable consideration of the advancement of technology and via research if necessary.
 - The Director will report the request to the Chancellor along with their findings and opinions. The Chancellor and the Director will consult with each other to arrive to a final decision. The Director will then execute the request or provide the denial.
 - If the Chancellor fails to reply within 48 hours of receiving the report from the Director, it will fall to the Director to weigh and execute a final decision.
- Will be responsible for developing and maintaining technology registries for archiving.

7. Director of Constitutional and Roleplay Law

- Is chiefly responsible for and charged with ensuring that the principles and rules outlined in the Constitution are fairly upheld and executed, so that all members of the region are protected by the law.
 - Will be responsible for reviewing member-nation inquiries and determining if any action taken by the Government of Asiana or the members-nations violates any of the regions rules and laws.
 - Should it be determined by the Director that such violation has occurred they will present a report jointly to the Chancellor of the Region and the People's Prime Minister.
 - The report will include an opinion on the matter from the Director and a suggested course of action.
- Will act to ensure a fair and balanced roleplaying environment in Asiana by not only overseeing Regional Message Board RP posts, but by accepting and reviewing requests and inquiries by member-nations.
 - Weighing the requests and inquiries against the laws of Asiana, the Director will provide a report of their findings and positions to the

Chancellor. The Chancellor and the Director will consult with each other to arrive to a final decision. The Director will then execute the request or provide the denial.

- If the Chancellor fails to reply within 48 hours of receiving the report from the Director, it will fall to the Director to weigh and execute a final decision.
- Ensuring that the principles of the laws, the consideration of the member-nations and spirit of Asiana is maintained, the Director will be charged with regularly reviewing the laws and policies of Asiana.
 - The Director will have the right to either propose new laws or amend existing laws for the betterment of Asiana.
