

- **Bare minimum:**

- Do no harm: Party orgs should use moment to fundraise for direct service orgs or to mobilize supporters for events pushing legislative solutions. They should not fundraise into committees that support anti-choice Democrats.
- Pro active: If Congress won't act, push attention local - do events for DLCC/state house/senate caucuses, pro-choice state local electeds & pro-choice prosecutors who refuse to charge for abortion in red states, etc
- Use the word "abortion" without hesitation or caveat!
- A commitment from all Democrats in the caucus that they support choice and are pro abortion legislation (could be actualized through a press conference or something like that)

- **Policy solutions:**

- Explore options to provide abortion care on federal lands such as military bases, embassies, or even national parks.
- Paid leave for federal employees/contractors who get abortions/experience pregnancy loss
- Executive order to restrict negative impact of crisis pregnancy centers
- Other executive order ideas which there must be many many of
- Use WH bully pulpit to lift up state-based policy solutions like CT's safe haven law enacted in response to TX ban and encourage other Democratic legislatures to follow suit
- Massive justice department initiative to protect people on from facing criminal consequences for seeking needed healthcare
- Justice department support for lawsuits seeking new grounds for abortion rights including 14th amendment equal rights and 1st amendment religious freedoms
- Explore options to provide abortion medication via telehealth and the mail (or at the very least bring in experts to lift up the safety of these options)
- Federal funding for abortion funds in states where abortion is banned
- Set up federal hotline/textline for those seeking abortion access to help navigate the system
- Apply/share/gift COVID vaccine tech (finding appointments, etc) to abortion clinics
- Increase access/affordability for emergency contraception

- **Communications solutions:**

- Invite people who've had abortions to the White House to tell their stories
 - Or to the Press Briefing Room
- Invite Jewish, Muslim, and other faith leaders to WH to discuss how abortion care is part of their faith traditions
- Go work as a clinic escort (either WH leadership or MOCs)
- WH.gov page/social platforms with lists of abortion funds, ways you can access abortion care in states
- Invite abortion fund leaders to the WH
- Invite doctors to discuss how abortion care saves lives
 - Also risks of maternal mortality, challenges to access pre-natal care, reduction of maternity wards at hospitals, etc.
- Invite police investigators to discuss increased risk of murder for pregnant people, especially Black pregnant people, as well as risks of pregnancy in abusive situations
- Invite social workers to discuss impact of pregnancy on young girls, particularly those too young to give consent, survivors of incest and other abuse
- A Women's Walk Out/General Strike
- Invite Democratic electeds/candidates who share their personal stories (double win: Helping other Democrats + sharing stories!)
- Invite celebrities and athletes to share their stories; partner with influencers in similar vein
- For all of these: Invite any/every Republican senator/member of Congress and all anti-filibuster-reform Democratic senator and make it known far and wide when they refuse to show up. Make it on them that they're hiding from the people their decisions are impacting. Turn them into the cowards.
- Presidential Medal to abortion providers
- Call for the indictment of Justices who committed perjury during their confirmation hearings

- **Congressional solutions:**

- Increased (and extremely public) pressure on Manchin, Sinema, Collins and Murkowski, including potential defunding of programs connected to their states and personal interests
- Renewed and highly prioritized work to provide statehood for DC and Puerto Rico
