2026 Open Education Talks Proposals Review Criteria

Adapted from OE Global Conference

Proposals for the Open Education Talks 2026 must include:

- Identification of all speakers and their roles
- A session title
- An abstract (maximum 500 words, including 2-4 references if applicable)
- 2-5 key concepts
- Enough details are provided to assess the context, relevance, goals, and key takeaways of the proposed session.

Submission details are reviewed based on the following criteria:

- **Relevance**: Does the submission relate to one or more streams? Is it clear how the submission is related to open education?
- Clarity and Coherence: Does the submission explain the aim (s) of the proposal clearly and understandably and in consistency with the requirement of the call?
- Learning Outcomes: Does the submission explain what participants can expect to learn in the session or how the session will advance their understanding of Open Education?
