



THE SAN ANDREAS SUPREME COURT

Petition for Pardon Guidelines

The Supreme Court of San Andreas has the authority to grant a pardon to a person who was convicted in the Supreme Court of any Capital Crimes

The form must be completed fully and accurately in order to be considered. You may attach to the petition additional pages and documents that amplify or clarify your answer to any question.

The failure to fully and accurately complete the application form may be construed as a falsification of the petition, which may provide a reason for denying your petition. In addition, the knowing and willful falsification of a document submitted to the government may subject you to criminal punishment, including up to five years' imprisonment and a \$100,000 fine.

This application is **NOT** valid until signed by a Supreme Court Justice.

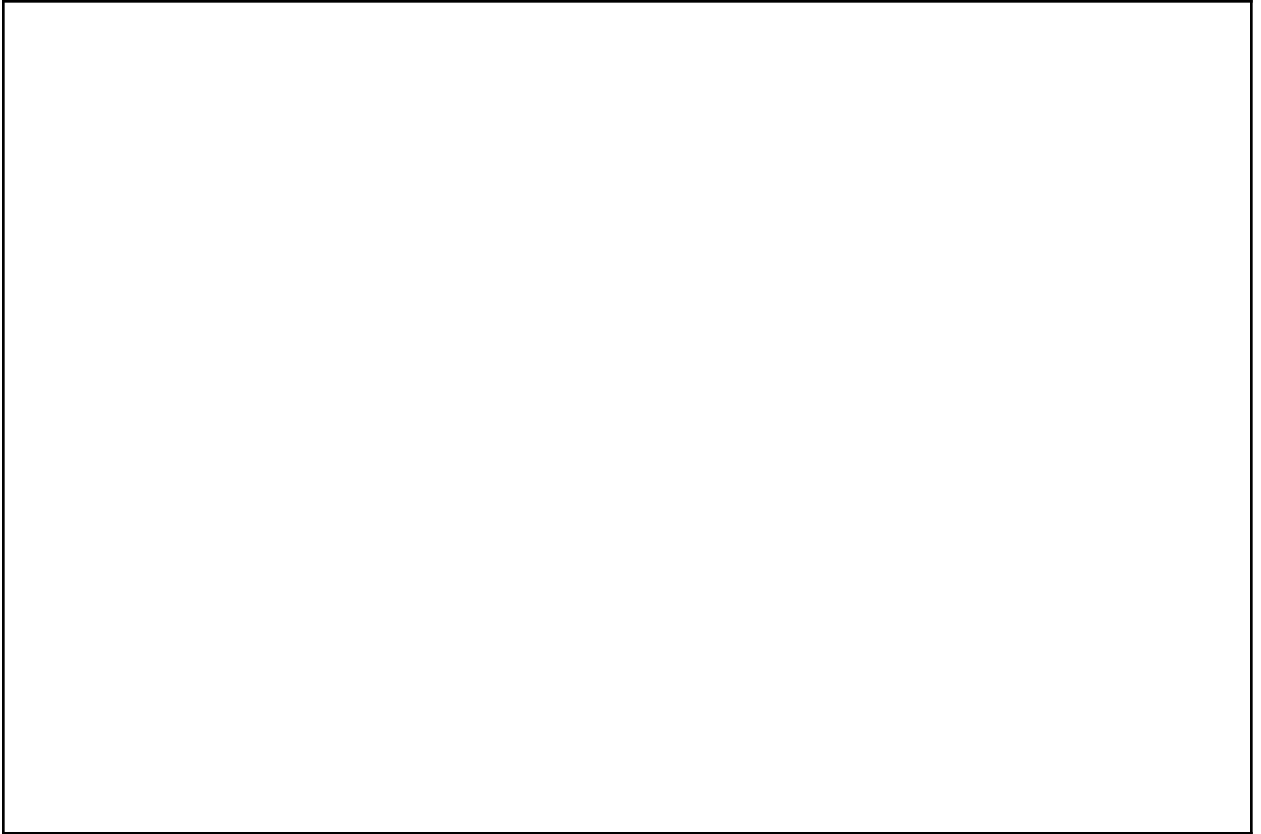

If the conviction resulted from a plea agreement, you should describe the full extent of your involvement in the criminal conduct, in addition to the charge(s) to which you pled guilty. If you need more space, use the optional continuation page.

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Section 3 - Prior and Subsequent Criminal Record

3.1 - Aside from the offense for which you seek pardon, have you ever been arrested, taken into custody, held for investigation or questioning, charged by any law enforcement authority, or convicted in any court, either as a juvenile or an adult, for any other incident? **No** ▾

4.4 - If you are self-employed, state the number of individuals you employ on both a full-time basis _____ and a part-time basis _____, if any, and state the name, address, and telephone number of an individual acquainted with you in a professional capacity, who are familiar with your professional performance and reputation.

Section 5 - Substance Abuse
