




Wednesday, December 1 - Term 2 courses are available to teachers

You will want to prepare Term 2 courses prior to the first day of the term, Monday, December 7th. Below is a suggested "order of operations."


1. Reorder Courses

Your Term 2 2020-21 courses will appear at the bottom of your course list. You may want to reorder this list.




- a. Tap/click the Course Dashboard.
- b. Drag and drop the course tiles to the order you prefer.

- 2. Link Sections
- 3. Copy your grade book settings to your Term 2 courses
- 4. Move Course Materials from Resources
- 5. Update Final Grade Settings



- a. Select Secondary Task Rubric from the Gradebook Scale drop down menu.
- b. Since the Secondary Task Rubric scale is point based, you are not able to round grades.
- 6. Visibility Settings



Do not check Hide overall grade or Hide grading period grades in student grade report. Hiding these grades hinders teachers accessing grades in the Advisory Dashboard.

7. Design Course
