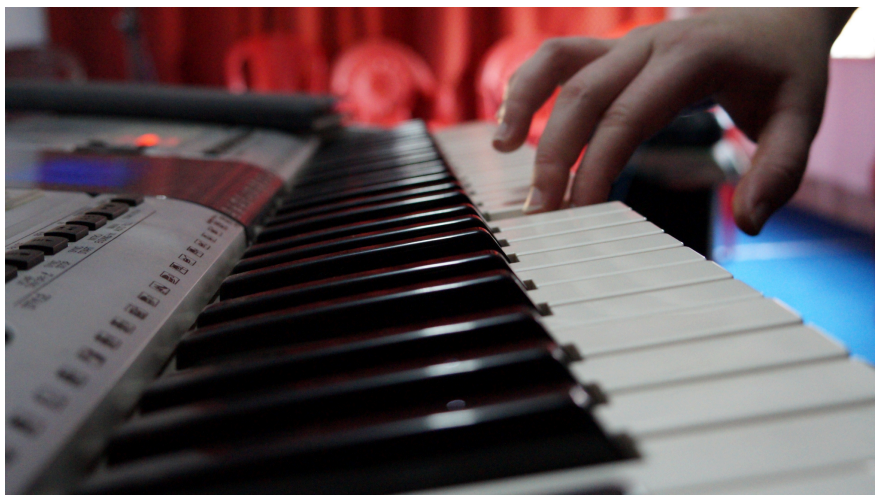


Year 7: Music

Create your own piece of music using the pentatonic scale



Using the pentatonic scale (use only the black notes on a piano keyboard), compose a short piece of music. Experiment with different note combinations and rhythms. When you're ready, record it and upload it to Google Classroom.



Guidance/key questions to ponder:

- Give your piece a clear beginning, middle and end
- What feeling or mood do you want to express? Experiment with different rhythms and tempos (speed)
- How can you create variety in your music, even with just five notes?
- *Alternatively, if you play another instrument, you could create a piece using only the notes C, D, E, G and A*
