CTE 10: 3 Application Information for Fall of 2025 college juniors and seniors

We hope this message finds you well. As you anticipate your junior or senior year of college, we want to inform you of a scholarship opportunity.

CTE 10 is a partnership of thirty-five school districts in Western Wisconsin. All of the participating districts are in a ten-county region that includes Buffalo, Chippewa, Clark, Dunn, Eau Claire, Jackson, Pepin, Rusk, Taylor, and Trempealeau. For a full list of member schools, click [here](#).

CTE 10 is offering \$10,000 scholarships to college juniors and seniors (in the fall of 2025) majoring in Career and Technical Education. This includes Agricultural Education, Business and Marketing Education, Family and Consumer Science Education, and Technology Education.

Students who are awarded these scholarships will receive \$5000 each semester as long as they remain in good academic standing.

How do you apply?

2. Review the CTE 10:3 [Evaluation Rubric](#); this is how your application will be evaluated.
3. Use this [link](#) to complete and submit your application.
4. Applications are due on March 3, 2025, by midnight.

When will I know if I am awarded a Scholarship?

1. Notification of awards will occur the week of April 7, 2025. All applicants will be notified of their standing, whether they are awarded a scholarship or not.
2. Upon receipt of the award, candidates agree to send their transcripts at the completion of the current semester (spring 2025) and at the end of the Fall 2025 semester. Funds will be disbursed to the Bursar on your campus, \$5000 in the Fall and \$5000 in the Spring.
