Literacy SMARTIE Goals

School Literacy Goal (This represents the overall student achievement of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for <u>all</u> students, and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

By the end of 2023-2024, at least 64% of Hispanic students in grades K-2 will meet the literacy benchmark in DIBELS with a composite score of 420 or higher. (Increase from 59% to 64%)

By the end of 2023-2024, at least 44% of Hispanic students in grades 3-5 will meet the literacy benchmark on MAP-R with a RIT score of 3 or higher. (Increase from 39% to 44%)

By the end of 2023-2024, at least 44% of Hispanic EML students will meet the literacy benchmarks on DIBELS or MAP-R. (Increase from 39% to 44%)

Math SMARTIE Goals
