Every race has the main race and in addition free children's run.

Distance and course:

There are two distances: 8km and 4km.

Course includes different man-made and natural obstacles. For example you have to carry heavy items, crawl under the net, climb over the wall, run over the pontoon bridge on the water etc.

Course is marked with barricade tape, signs and volunteers.

The use of spiked shoes is forbidden to maintain the good condition of obstacles for all participants!
