**Community Relations Subcommittee Meeting**  
**Wednesday, December 8 – 6:30 PM via Zoom**  
**Minutes**

**Present:** Patti Bernheart (Subcommittee Member, Meeting Chair), Joe Ciampa (Subcommittee Member), Bill Hodges (Subcommittee Member), Zillie Bhuju (School Committee Chair, *ex officio* Subcommittee Member)

- A. **Community Forum.** The Community Relations Subcommittee invited all members of the Tri-Town community to join us for an open discussion. No community participants joined the meeting.
- B. **Updates from community organizations. Councils on Aging** - representatives from Topsfield and Middleton are likely to attend our meeting on January 12th. Do we want to provide them with a summary ahead of time of what we'll be talking about or just allow them to share their interests and/or concerns around what is happening at Masco to foster that relationship as a community partner? We want to give them the message that they are a partner with Masco and we want to engage them. Idea: share Masco websites or Principal's Weekly Memo. Screen share to point out the Masco website, Principal's weekly memo and form through which organizations can request help (Community Assistance Program). **Action:** Subcommittee to be prepared to screen share Masco Memo from Principal and other things on the website (stated above); be prepared to discuss Masco athletics, art/music/drama events, etc. with Councils on Aging. If members of COA wanted to attend any of the events, we could waive the fee so that they can join.
- C. **Masco concert for senior citizens.** Bill Hodges continues to review with Randy O'Keefe. Winter may be difficult because of other events at school including the drama program. Awaiting confirmation from Randy about earliest date when a concert might be feasible. **Action:** Bill to follow up at January 12 meeting.
- D. **Internships.** Bill Hodges has gathered a few contacts from businesses we have partnered with in the past. He will reach out to them to get a sense of what they are getting from Masco and what, if anything, we could be doing additionally to foster positive relationships with them as business partners. Action: Bill to pursue these discussions.
- E. Other business. Zillie Bhuju asked if the sub committee wants to consider running meetings around certain themes being discussed in the community (i.e., focus on themes as well as groups).
