1. Welcome/Introductions/Celebrations

In attendance via Zoom: Sally Wennes, Maja Primorac, Robin Seldin, Alia Tate, Sarah Lepitz, Sharon Thompson, Tom Jennings

2. Review and Approval of the Minutes/Action

- a. Maja made a motion to move approval of last meeting minutes to the next meeting. approve the minutes. Sally seconded
- b. Vote: unanimous approval to move the approval to December meeting

3. Review and Analyze Student Achievement Data. Identified student group performance levels, including greatest needs and performance gaps.

7. OTHER TOPICS / PUBLIC COMMENT

- a. Coyote and fencing - Maja asked the Council if they would support efforts to request a new and upgraded fence for safety reasons. Council unanimously agreed that more information is needed before they can proceed.
 - i. Coyote visited as early as 7:40 am, but it did not react to the horn.
 - ii. Sally informed the council that the School Resource Officer has been a great resource. He helped contact animal control the last time the coyote visited.
 - iii. Discussed to potentially ask the custodian to walk the perimeter.
 - iv. Recommended to look into light sensors and cameras that have animal motion detectors.
- b. Parking Lot - Sally mentioned that the parking lot is dark and we might need additional lights installed there.
- c. Bullying - Discussed strategies to address bullying. Sally to review district tools and see how to better apply to MES.
- d. Communications - Maja suggested to remind parents to download ParentSquare and to emphasize that this is the primary communication tool for our school and the district. Sally will communicate this in the next Spotlight.
- e. Lice - Sally informed the Council of the new lice policy. If there is one lice case in class, the class is to be informed. However, students can stay in school even if they have live lice. Sally will ask the district to provide deep cleaning in all classrooms. Maja suggested asking the nurses to go to each MES class and educate the students on lice and lice prevention.
