Here, we can easily see that the whole data and the UX (components and their placements), everything is plain copy/pasted.

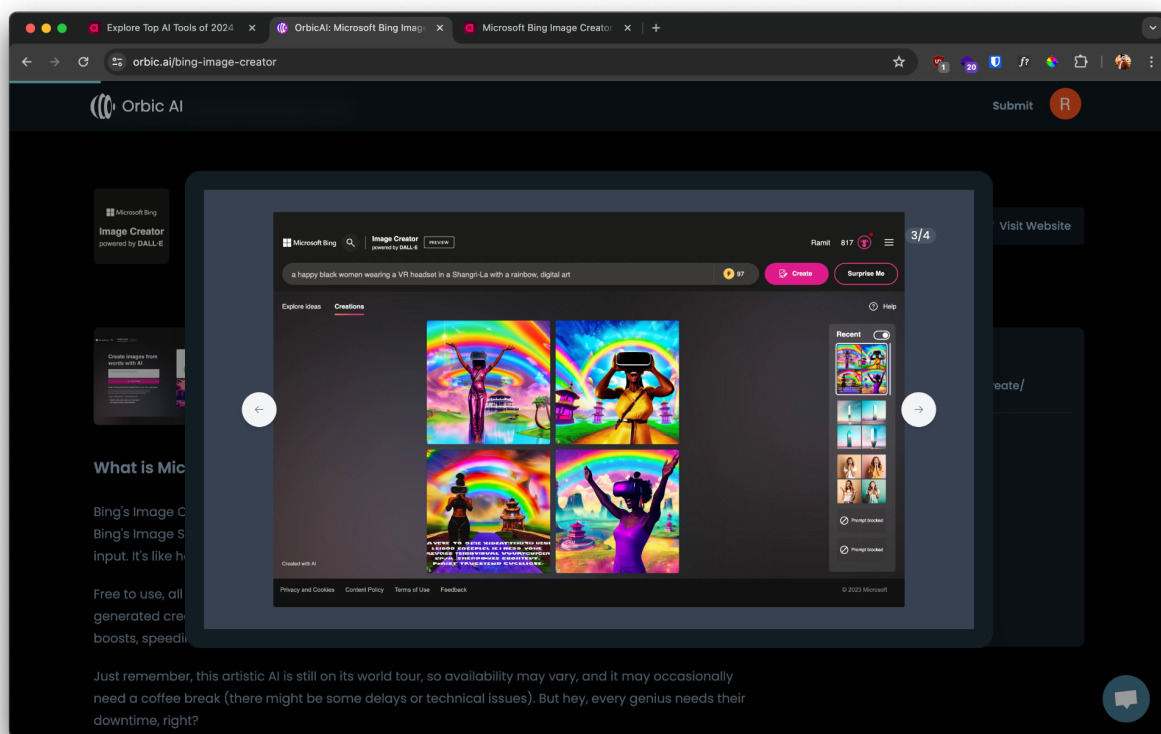
The owner has even replicated the same page structure, slugs and images and their filename as well.
