

Robot/Teams Entrance: Teams should enter from the WEST side of the building. From this entrance, you will enter the building on the same level as the pits and playing field.

Spectator Entrance: Parents and spectators should enter the building from the lobby, in the NORTHEAST corner of the building.

<u>Tours:</u> Tours will be made available throughout the day. *You* are going to want to see this beautiful facility!

If you are running late, please call the Event Coordinator to inform them of your arrival time. Match schedules can't be run until all teams are present.

Projected Event Outline/Schedule

7:30 AM	Doors Open
8:00 AM	Registration Starts – Submit your roster.
8:00 AM	Inspections Begin – Size, labels, safety, functionality, self-inspection sheet, etc.
9:30 AM	Match Schedule Given – start scouting!
10:00 AM	DECODE Matches Begin – Each team will play <u>6 matches</u> .
12:00 PM	Pack up, clean up and go home – Please clean your pit area and ensure you have everything!

Set up your Pit Table

Each team will be provided with one table. Teams may decorate tables and can bring items to exchange with other teams, (buttons, pencils, etc.). Please do not bring any noise makers. Each team is responsible for their personal belongings that they bring to the meet. **Do not leave valuables unattended. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items**. Have all of your equipment marked with your team number, most importantly your batteries and chargers. You may consider bringing a tub or trash bag for storing coats and such under your table. Due to space constraint you may not be given a 10 foot by 10 foot space. Respect the space given and keep aisle ways clear.

Power Availability in the Pit Area

Power outlets will be available at or near each table. Plan to have laptops, phones, and batteries fully charged before arriving. No power tool use, such as cutting or grinding at pit tables.

Required Items to Bring

- Safety Glasses for all team members and visitors to the pits. Everyone in the pit area or competing at
 the field is required to wear safety glasses or have side shields on their prescription glasses. Safety
 glasses will NOT be provided.
- **Team Roster** from the FIRST dashboard, press the big blue button to print. All students need to be electronically registered and listed on the roster. Electronic consent and release forms need to be signed for each team member.
- A completed Inspection Checklist (highly suggested)

- Robot, Tools, Batteries, Chargers, Computers, Controllers, USB cables, etc.
