Premier Academy Team Travel Policies and Information

PREMIER PLAYER TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS, PLANNING & POLICIES

Travel Arrangements and Planning:

1. Premier families are responsible for all player travel. This includes purchasing and booking flights, securing a hotel room at the team hotel, transportation and meals. If a parent cannot attend a tournament with their player, they must arrange adult supervision, lodging, transportation to and from games and provide them with money for meals.

***Players and Coaches are expected to be at the team hotel the day before their first tournament game. Unless otherwise cleared with your coach.**

2. Travel fees for head and assistant coaches, including flights, hotel, rental cars and food are included in the total season cost. *Fees are subject to change if events are added, modified or dropped.* Each team member is responsible for covering their portion of the coaches travel fees **even if they are not attending the tournament.**

3. Premier requires all players to stay in the team hotel. **Premier Staff** will assign your team a hotel and a block of rooms for **every travel tournament**. We will let you know when your team needs to make their hotel reservations before the block will be released to other prospective guests. We try to have this for you at least 30 days in advance.

4. PLEASE NOTE: IF YOU PUT YOUR PLAYER ON A FLIGHT ALONE, YOUR TEAM COACH IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR TRANSPORTATION TRANSFERS BETWEEN THE AIRPORT AND HOTEL. PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOUR PLAYER HAS A CHAPERONE AND PLANNED TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS AT ALL TIMES.

Player Account Standing:

In order for Premier players to attend travel tournaments, their Premier billing account must be in good standing. Should a player have any outstanding balances, the player will not be allowed to attend the tournament.

Safety and Security:

The safety and security of our athletes is our first priority when traveling.

- Coaches will establish a LIGHTS OUT/CURFEW and WAKE UP time daily. We ask that the curfew never be later than 11:00pm (preferably earlier!). This rule is enforced for ALL PLAYERS even though they are staying with parents or chaperones.
- No male coaches or chaperones are allowed in girl's player rooms at any time. Failure to respect this rule will result in immediate expulsion from the club.
- Hotel room doors are NOT TO BE PROPPED OPEN UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.
- We operate on the buddy system. Players are NEVER TO BE ALONE when outside of their hotel room, including game facilities. They must have a teammate or parent/guardian with them at all times. Players should always tell a parent/guardian or another teammate where they are going.
- In-room movies and adult entertainment options are to be disabled by coach/team manager upon check in at all hotel rooms in Premier block.

PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILD or if they are acting as a chaperone for another player, they are responsible for that player for the duration of the trip. It is the parent responsibility to make sure players have a parent/chaperone, follow behavior expectations, and are at the hotel and games on time as designated by your team coach.

Food and Dining:

- Parents/chaperones must provide food money for all player meals. It is suggested that players have at least \$35/day for food.
- We budget \$35 a day per coach for all Premier teams.
- Coaches/Team Managers need to plan a designated team breakfast time daily and at least one team lunch or dinner per day.

Player Behavior Expectations: Before each travel tournament, parents and coaches are to review the below behavior expectations with players.

- Players are expected to act polite and respectful to all opposing players, fans, parents, hotel staff and tournament staff. They are to represent themselves, their families, team and Premier with the utmost class and integrity.
- Players are expected to follow the Premier Attire Policy during the duration of a travel tournament.
- There is to be no running or yelling in or outside of the hotels.
- Players are expected to be on time for meetings, breakfast, team meals, games and any and all other team functions as directed by the team coach.
- We have ZERO TOLERANCE for fighting, drugs or alcohol use or any other inappropriate behavior. Players found to have participated in these behaviors/activities will be immediately removed from the team and sent home.

- Premier Coaches are required to wear a Nike Premier Polo or Nike Premier T-Shirt with Jeans, Slacks, Nike Shorts, Sweats or Leggings and Nike Shoes when traveling.
- **We are a NIKE SPONSORED ORGANIZATION. Please make sure that you do not wear competitor shoes or attire while traveling for Premier events.**

Packing List: We do not want players to check any bags! ***Players are required to bring the following items in their "carry-on" bag if they are flying.***

- Basketball Bag & Deflated Basketball
- Basketball Shoes & 6 Pairs of Basketball Socks
- BOTH Color Uniform Jersey and Shorts and Warm Up
- Premier T-Shirt
- Empty Water Bottle
- Toiletry items in a zip lock baggie. Liquids must be 3 oz. or less.
