

Piaget Stations

Station 1: Take one of the cups filled with water and pour it into the tall beaker. How would a 3 year old answer the following question:

Which glass has more water?

Station 2: How would a 3 year old answer the following question:

Which row has more checkers?

Station 3: Take a look at both sides of the cereal box. After looking at both sides, predict what the other person is seeing on their side if you were three years old.

Station 4: The two sticks are aligned equally – move one stick a few inches to the right. How would a 3 year old answer the following question:

Are the sticks the same size? If not, which one is longer?

Station 5: Take one of the balls of play-doh and flatten it out.

Which of the play-doh's is larger? How would a 3 year old answer?

Materials Needed

- short, wide beaker
- tall, skinny beaker
- 10 checkers
- cereal box
- two popsicle sticks
- play dough
