

Packing List, March 15-17 2019

Label everything when possible

Clothing

- ☐ BSA Field Uniform (wear on arrival)
- ☐ 2 pairs of pants (artificial fibers are best)
- ☐ 2 long-sleeved shirts (artificial fibers or wool are best)
- ☐ Base layer (long underwear), if needed
- ☐ Fleece jacket or other mid-layer
- ☐ Winter jacket and/or Rain jacket/poncho, depending on weather
- ☐ Sleepwear - base layer can be worn
- ☐ 3 pairs socks (wool or artificial fibers)
- ☐ Underwear
- ☐ Hiking shoes/boots (broken in)
- ☐ Extra pair of shoes (no open toe)
- ☐ Warm hat (wool or fleece)
- ☐ Sun hat
- ☐ Gloves

Bedding

- ☐ Sleeping bag
- ☐ Sleeping pad
- ☐ Inflatable pillow (optional)

Personal Gear

- ☐ Backpack or Duffle Bag containing all other gear
- ☐ Daypack
- ☐ 2 water bottles, filled
- ☐ Headlamp or flashlight, extra batteries
- ☐ Something to sit on - sit pad, sleeping pad conversion kit, folding chair, etc.
- ☐ Extra stuff sacks or ziplock bags

☐ Mess kit

- ☐ Eating utensil(s)
- ☐ Bowl (optional if doing freezer bag cooking)
- ☐ Cup
- ☐ Personal First Aid Kit

Toiletries

- ☐ Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- ☐ Deodorant
- ☐ Biodegradable soap
- ☐ Small towel
- ☐ Comb or brush
- ☐ Lip balm, with sun protection
- ☐ Toilet paper, removed from roll, in ziplock bag
- ☐ Hand sanitizer
- ☐ Feminine hygiene products, as needed
- ☐ Sunscreen, as needed

Other items

- ☐ Medications - labeled with Scout's name, medication name, dosage
- ☐ Scouts BSA Handbook
- ☐ Wristwatch (optional)
- ☐ Small notebook and pencils
- ☐ Compass (if you have one)
- ☐ Pocketknife (only one)
- ☐ Card games (optional)
- ☐ Matches in waterproof case or other fire starting method
- ☐ Backpacking stove and fuel (optional)

Note on electronic devices: During Scouting activities, we keep our focus on Scouting. Scouts may bring cell phones, but they are only to be used for approved Scouting purposes such as navigation and photography. Scouts may not bring other electronics such as tablets and game systems, and may not use cell phones for entertainment purposes such as watching videos, playing games, etc. Scouts will be expected to turn their cell phones in to an adult leader if it is a distraction.

Note on tents: If you have a tent, please bring it to the meeting on March 10 so we can determine which tents we will bring on the campout and whether we need to borrow any tents from another unit.
