Open Discussion/Other Business/items of note:

- Discussion re fundraisers vs donations. Data, benefits, concerns, logistics
 - Possibility of a survey to get community feedback
 - Add a "non fundraiser fundraiser"
 - Data on how many families typically participate in fundraisers
 - 572 students total at beginning of year
 - 97 students sold pies
 - 112 people bought mums
 - Some concern over families that did participate may not in the future or may not donate the dollar amount they generated in the fundraisers
 - Button has now been added in Cheddar up for straight donations
 - Possibility of a year end option for a donation request letter
 - o Agreement not to call it an "OR" with donation or fundraiser
 - Cheddar up can do a check vs. credit card to account for fees
 - Whether the buyer covers the fee is set per fundraiser, not buyer choice
 - Advertise that some employers will match donations

- Book vending machine
 - New or like new books only
 - o There is an option through scholastic online and the book fair to donate books
- Suggestion regarding teacher questions and sharing info to make gift giving easier
 - Megan: idea of surveying the staff for their favorite things to aid in gift giving.
 (colors, stores, restaurants, etc.)
 - Where would we store this information? Security/Privacy concern
 - Conflict of interest concern
 - Teachers currently send welcome letters and some facts during open house
- How can the PAC continue to improve?
- Translation to other languages
 - Legal obligations based on school demographics
 - Provide information in text for translation
