High Holy Days Committee

Responsibilities include meeting to work on High Holy Day preparations, planning, and execution of High Holy Days Services. Volunteers need to be knowledgeable about High Holy Days and willing to work with the existing committee members.

 Each congregation of CARC is entitled to up to 3 members. A volunteer representative would attend board meetings once a month. In addition, they would have the opportunity to participate in various community groups on behalf of CARC (such as the Greater Carlisle Community Response Network, Moving Circles/NIOT (Not in Our Town), the Carlisle Labyrinth project, Community Action Network (CAN), and the Living Water Dental Clinic. CARC holds 3 interfaith services per year for Thanksgiving eve; MLK, Jr. service, and Holocaust service.
