<u>Dedicating Our Children is Not a Requirement – It is a Privilege</u>

We Live in a Covenant relationship with God by Faith in Christ – We Receive and Dedicate

The First Born Were "Presented to the Lord."

Luke 2:22 And when the days for their purification according to the law of Moses were completed, **they brought Him up to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord**

<u>Jesus Blessed Children – We Do Too</u>

Mark 10:13-16 And they were bringing children to Him so that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked them. 14 But when Jesus saw this, He was indignant and said to them, "Permit the children to come to Me; do not hinder them; for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. 15 "Truly I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it at all." 16 And He took them in His arms and began blessing them, laying His hands on them.

God Dedicated Us - "Sealed" Us and "Gave Us the Spirit in Our Hearts as a Pledge"

2 Corinthians 1:20-22 For as many as are the promises of God, in Him they are yes; therefore also through Him is our Amen to the glory of God through us. 21 Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and anointed us is God, 22 who also sealed us and gave us the Spirit in our hearts as a pledge.

All That We Have Comes from God

1 Chronicles 29:12 "Both riches and honor *come* from You, and You rule over all, and in Your hand is power and might; and it lies in Your hand to make great and to strengthen everyone. 13 "Now therefore, our God, we thank You, and praise Your glorious name. 14 "But who am I and who are my people that we should be able to offer as generously as this? For all things come from You, and from Your hand we have given You.

James 1:17 Every good thing given and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shifting shadow.

Romans 11:36 For <u>from Him and through Him and to Him are all things</u>. To Him *be* the glory forever. Amen.

1 Samuel 1:26=28 She said, "Oh, my lord! As your soul lives, my lord, I am the woman who stood here beside you, praying to the LORD. 27 "For this boy I prayed, and the LORD has given me my petition which I asked of Him. 28 "So I have also dedicated him to the LORD; as long as he lives he is dedicated to the LORD." And he worshiped the LORD there.

Devoted to God Who Chose Us

Colossians 3:12 So, <u>as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved</u>, <u>put on a heart of compassion</u>, <u>kindness</u>, <u>humility</u>, <u>gentleness and patience</u>; <u>13 bearing with one another</u>, <u>and forgiving each other</u>, <u>whoever has a complaint against anyone</u>; <u>just as the Lord forgave you</u>, <u>so also should you</u>. <u>14 Beyond all these things <u>put on love</u>, <u>which is the perfect bond of unity</u>.</u>

Colossians 4:2 Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with an attitude of thanksgiving;

Devoted to One Another in the Lord

Romans 12:10 Be devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor; 11 not lagging behind in diligence, <u>fervent in spirit</u>, <u>serving the Lord</u>; 12 rejoicing in hope, <u>persevering in tribulation</u>, <u>devoted to prayer</u>, 13 contributing to the needs of the saints, practicing hospitality.
