| Two Stars & One Wish | Give someone two celebrations about their work and one wish about it. Ex. I give you a star for your details. I give you a star for hooking the reader in your introduction. I wish you would add more dialogue to your story. |
| T. A. G. | T = Tell a compliment A = Ask a question G = Give a suggestion Ex. I like how you solved that problem. What made you think of using that strategy? Next time you should more details in your work. |

| Roll a Die for a comment | Roll a die. Read the number. Give a comment with that many words. |
| Wonder Statements | I wonder why Ex. I am wondering why you chose to write about frogs. |
| Day of the Week Focus | Marvelous Mondays - Find a marvelous learning and tell why. #hashtag Tuesdays - Comment w/#hashtags. Wishful Wednesdays - Make a wishful comment. Thankful Thursdays - Be thankful in your comment. Future Friday - Think into the future with a comment and give a suggestion. |
| Six Word Comment | Adapted from SOS Strategy, <u>Six Word Summary</u> , give a 6 word comment. |
| 3 - 2 - 1 | Give 3 celebrations, 2 questions, and 1 suggestion. Ex. I'm giving a big woohoo on your coloring, title, and details. Where do you get your ideas? How do you color so vividly? Next time I'd like to see a closing sentence that ends it with a bang. |
| Reflect and Set a Goal | Things I do well Things I need to work on Ex. I am good at hooking the reader and adding details. My goal is to slow down and check my work when it is done, so that I don't make silly mistakes. |

| SMART Goal | I want to by I will to meet my goal. |
