<b>Compliment</b>	Give a compliment that builds someone up. Share a compliment and don't forget to say why. <i>Ex. I love how you used details to describe the main character.</i>

<b>The DAB</b>	<a href="#">DAB</a> D = Deliver a Compliment A = Ask a Question B = Be Positive with a Suggestion  **created by Mrs. Schuhmacher's 2nd graders
<b>Two Stars &amp; One Wish</b>	Give someone two celebrations about their work and one wish about it. <i>Ex. I give you a star for your details. I give you a star for hooking the reader in your introduction. I wish you would add more dialogue to your story.</i>
<b>T. A. G.</b>	T = Tell a compliment A = Ask a question G = Give a suggestion <i>Ex. I like how you solved that problem. What made you think of using that strategy? Next time you should more details in your work.</i>
<b>Emoji Compliment</b>	Use emojis only to comment. 👍 📖 💜 💭 (nice writing, love the ideas)

<b>Growth Mindset Feedback</b>	<p>Providing <a href="#">constructive feedback</a> in growth minded language.</p> <p><i>Ex. When you think you cannot do it, remind yourself that you can't do it yet.</i></p>
<b>Roll a Die for a comment</b>	Roll a die. Read the number. Give a comment with that many words.
<b>Wonder Statements</b>	<p>I wonder why . . .</p> <p><i>Ex. I am wondering why you chose to write about frogs.</i></p>
<b>Day of the Week Focus</b>	<p>Marvelous Mondays - Find a marvelous learning and tell why.</p> <p>#hashtag Tuesdays - Comment w/#hashtags.</p> <p>Wishful Wednesdays - Make a wishful comment.</p> <p>Thankful Thursdays - Be thankful in your comment.</p> <p>Future Friday - Think into the future with a comment and give a suggestion.</p>
<b>Six Word Comment</b>	Adapted from SOS Strategy, <a href="#">Six Word Summary</a> , give a 6 word comment.
<b>3 - 2 - 1</b>	Give 3 celebrations, 2 questions, and 1 suggestion. <i>Ex. I'm giving a big woohoo on your coloring, title, and details. Where do you get your ideas? How do you color so vividly? Next time I'd like to see a closing sentence that ends it with a bang.</i>
<b>Reflect and Set a Goal</b>	<p>Things I do well . . .</p> <p>Things I need to work on . . .</p> <p><i>Ex. I am good at hooking the reader and adding details. My goal is to slow down and check my work when it is done, so that I don't make silly mistakes.</i></p>
