

Role Description: Gospel Community Leader

POSITION: Gospel Community Leader

RESPONSIBLE TO: Gospel Community Coach

DESCRIPTION:

Gospel Community Leaders are responsible for providing his or her group with vision, direction, and support. Leaders are successful when they are personally growing in their intimacy with God, community with insiders, and influence with outsiders, and are leading their groups in such a way as to encourage the group members' growth in these three relationships as well.

PREREQUISITES:

- 1. Attend Summer Leadership Assessment Cohort
- 2. Complete Connection Church's leadership assessment
- 3. Have participated in a small group for at least one year (two semesters)
- 4. Be committed to maintaining unity by understanding and supporting the core values of Connection Church
- 5. Be recommended by a GC leader or coach.
- 6. Have a growing, personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- 7. Be an active covenant member of Connection Church

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Attend leadership trainings and meetings (75% attendance required)
- 2. Plan for and coordinate your GCs meeting. Complete attendance on Planning Center.
- 3. Pray for everyone in your group and your coach
- 4. Contact members of your group on a regular basis. This can be done through email, phone calls, one-on-one get together, or going out with them as a group. Build ownership in your group by asking for help and creating a core team
- 5. Prepare for small group discussion. Facilitate group discussion, questions, and challenges that will enable the group to grow deeper in their walk with Christ
- 6. Identify an apprentice leader and develop his or her small group leadership skills by mentoring them
- 7. Make yourself available to you group members for general care

TIME COMMITMENT:

- 1. Weekly preparation/prayer for discussions
- 2. Weekly check-in with your core team members via text, phone call, or video call
- 3. Weekly gathering with your group
- 4. Monthly GC leader meetings (75% attendance required)
- 5. Summer development and care outlined by your GC coach
