

Middle School Registration Information

Helpful information!

CMS will run the 2026-2027 magnet/school assignment list in late January. Once we have that list, we will be able to register our future Mustangs! (Students need to be assigned to MPHS in Infinite Campus so we know who needs an MPHS registration card.)

Myers Park HS is aware that other high schools may have earlier registration dates.

We don't want our families to worry that they are missing a deadline. Turning in a registration card to your future high school "earlier" in no way impacts whether or not your student will get the classes they want.

MPHS Registration Timeline

Tuesday, February 10th at 6PM: Prospective Family Night at MPHS - rising 9th grade (and new to CMS) families invited to learn more about our curriculum, program options, etc. (Open to ALL families, not just CMS)

Friday, February 13th: We are asking all CMS Middle Schools to send MPHS registration cards home with 8th grade students.

Monday, February 23rd - Friday, February 27th : Card Collection - for CMS schools with 20+ future Mustangs, we will send counselors out to meet with your kids, review their requests, and put the requests into the computer.

If a CMS school has fewer than 20 kids coming to MPHS, cards will be sent to MP through courier.

All 9th grade MPHS students take the following courses:

English 1

Math (level depends on current placement)

Economics and Personal Finance

Earth/Environmental Science

Health/PE

Electives

ALTERNATES – **Please list at least four**, preferably 6

Helpful Notes:

English- ELD / EL English 9 is double-blocked for ML students . (less than 3 years in US and ACCESS Composite Score below a 3)

Math- Math I is offered as semester long (Honors) or as a year long class (in the A/B day column). The year-long class will take up 2 spots in the student's schedule.

**Students may NOT “double up” in math unless they plan to pursue the IB Diploma program and are taking all of the IB Diploma preparatory requirements.*

Economics/Personal Finance - This is the required 9th grade social studies class.

Science – Earth/Environmental is the required 9th grade science.

If the student plans to pursue the IB Diploma track and will have completed Math I and world language requirements, the student should select MYP Biology in addition to MYP Earth and Env. Science.

IB Diploma Preparatory Schedule Requirements

****This is ONLY for IB Diploma candidates. Not every student is a good fit for IB. Please discuss this option with your counselor to determine if this choice is the best option.**

- a. MYP English I
- b. MYP Math II (or above)
- c. MYP Econ P/F
- d. MYP Earth/Env Science
- e. MYP Biology
- f. MYP World Language II (or above)
- g. MYP PE/Health
- h. Elective
