(neat lines, nice coloring, gluing, painting, or cutting etc.) A little thought went into your idea, but you might have rushed into it. You followed directions with few reminders. You completed your work on time. You maintained a decent time on task, but may have talked some. You had a good attitude. You followed all classroom rules with no more than one warning. You left your work area clean. You used all art materials in a safe manner.	You “threw it together” - it lacks skill and shows poor craftsmanship. (Messy lines, sloppy cutting, messy coloring, and lots of erased lines that still show.) Very little thought or care. You did not follow directions the first time. You talked a lot and barely made any progress, You did not try very hard. You did just enough work to get by. You had trouble following the classroom rules. You needed to be reminded to use materials correctly and safely. Your area wasn’t clean- you left something out. You did just enough to get by and follow the project rules, but you did not try very hard.	You did not try very hard- no visible craftsmanship at all- extremely messy work. No thought or care. You did not follow directions. You spent more time talking than working. Little effort or participation, if any. You did not have a good attitude. You did not follow classroom rules. You did not use the art materials in a safe or correct manner. You left your area a mess. Your artwork is missing. Distracting to others.
