

**INTERLEAGUE BASEBALL RULES INTERMEDIATE (50-70) BASEBALL**  
**LAST UPDATED: 3/11/2023**

**Intermediate (50-70) Baseball – Spring 2024**

**All game rules are per current year Little League Rulebook unless noted otherwise.**

<b>PLAYER AGE</b>	Current Little League age chart in effect for current calendar year. League Age 13 is the maximum age allowed.
<b>GAME LENGTH</b>	7 Innings
<b>REGULATION GAME</b>	5 innings or 4 ½ if the home team is ahead.
<b>TIME LIMIT</b>	No new inning after 2 hours [A.R. to Rule 4.10(c)(2)]. A new inning starts when the third out is made in the previous inning. There is no drop-dead time. Ties will be played out up to the time limit.
<b>RUN RULE</b>	Little League Rule 4.10(e), is adopted. <i>15 runs after 3 and ½ innings</i> <i>10 runs after 4 and ½ innings</i> <i>8 runs after 5 and ½ innings.</i>
<b>RUNS PER INNING</b>	No limit
<b>DOUBLE HEADERS</b>	Allowed (Rule 4.13), but none scheduled Note: see pitching rules below Regulation VI(k).
<b>PITCHING DISTANCE</b>	50 Feet
<b>PITCHING RULES</b>	Per Little League Rule Book. Note: A pitcher remaining on defense in the game, but moving to a different position, can return as pitcher anytime in the remainder of the game, but only once per game, provided that the player is under the pitch limit [Regulation VI(b)].
<b>BALKS</b>	First half of the season (4/15/23 and earlier), each pitcher will get one warning on a balk. On the second balk by the same pitcher, runners are awarded bases per Green Book. After 4/15/23 there are no warnings on balks.
<b>BASE ON BALLS</b>	No limit
<b>BATTING ORDER</b>	Continuous. The batting order will be the entire roster.
<b>INTENTIONAL</b>	Little League Rule 6.08(a)(2) as amended for 2023.

<b>WALKS</b>	
<b>ON DECK BATTER</b>	Allowed
<b>DESIGNATED HITTER</b>	Not allowed
<b>UNCAUGHT THIRD STRIKE</b>	Batter may run on an uncaught third strike, per Little League Rule Book.

<b>MANDATORY PLAY</b>	Six (6) defensive outs, which need not be consecutive, and one (1) plate appearance [Regulation IV(i)].
<b>POOL PLAYERS</b>	Allowed. Pool players are not allowed to pitch. It is strongly recommended that they bat last and play outfield.
<b>BASE RUNNERS</b>	Per Little League Rule Book
<b>COURTESY RUNNER</b>	Little League Rule 7.14(b) is adopted. <i>Last out in continuous batting order can courtesy run for pitchers/catchers with 2 outs.</i>
<b>SPECIAL PINCH RUNNER</b>	Per Little League Rule 7.14, there are <u>no</u> special pinch runners, as continuous batting order is adopted.
<b>STEALING BASES</b>	Little League Rule Book
<b>BATTING PRACTICE</b>	Rule 1.16: Use of a helmet by the batter is mandatory during all types of batting practices. This includes players throwing or tossing the balls.
<b>WARMING UP PITCHERS</b>	Little League Rule 3.09, as amended for 2023. Managers and coaches are <u>permitted</u> to warm up pitchers.
<b>THE TEAM</b>	All players are to remain in the dugout unless batting, or on deck. The option in Rule 4.16 to start (or continue) a game with 8 players is adopted. If a team does not have 8 players, that game shall be recorded as a forfeit.
<b>DEFENSE</b>	Little League Rule Book
<b>BASE COACHES</b>	Little League Rule 4.05: two (2) base coaches are required. Both may be adults provided that one (1) adult remains in the dugout. Rule 1.16: base coaches under 18 years of age and all players must wear a helmet.
<b>OFFENSIVE CONFERENCES</b>	Little League Rule Book
<b>DEFENSIVE COACHES</b>	Not Allowed

<b>DEFENSIVE CONFERENCES</b>	Little League Rule Book
<b>LATE PLAYERS</b>	Little League Rule 4.01, Note 2
<b>INCAPACITATED PLAYERS</b>	Little League Rule Book
<b>SHOES</b>	Metal cleats are allowed per 1.11(h)
<b>JEWELRY</b>	Little League Rule 1.11(j), as amended for 2023.
<b>PROTESTS</b>	Little League Rule 4.19
<b>GAME BALLS</b>	Provided by the host league teams. Start with at least 4 baseballs per game

<b>SCOREKEEPER</b>	Provided by the host league teams. All games must have a score keeper.
<b>BASEBALL BATS</b>	<p>Per Little League Rule 1.10:</p> <p>USA Baseball performance standard bats with the USA baseball logo of any size and weight are permitted.</p> <p>BBCOR (Batted Ball Coefficient of Restitution) performance standard are permitted.</p> <p>Wood bats are permitted (solid one piece). No logo required.</p> <p>Bats without the USA baseball logo or the BBCOR logo are NOT permitted. (unless solid wood)</p> <p>BPF bats prohibited. USSSA bats prohibited.</p>
