Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back and Happy New Year!

We hope that you all had a lovely Christmas with your families. Thank you for all of the lovely gifts and cards, they were very much appreciated.

We are really looking forward to the term ahead!

#### PE

Outdoor PE will remain on a Thursday and indoor PE will continue to be on a Friday this half term. Please can children come to school wearing comfortable clothing and sensible shoes (trainers). Please ensure your child brings a named coat/warm clothing appropriate for the weather.

#### Outdoor/Orchard Sessions

We like to be outdoors as much as possible and the children have the opportunity to access outdoor learning on a daily basis. With the weather

being a little unpredictable, please could you ensure your child has a coat **every** day and appropriate footwear. All coats, hats, gloves and scarves should also be labelled with your child's name.

#### Homework

Each half term a homework challenge will be sent home, linked to the topic we are studying. You can choose which of these you would like to complete, and you can bring these into school, or share with us on Tapestry. You may choose 1 or 2 activities to complete.

#### Reading

The children are really enjoying choosing and sharing their library books with you at home. We kindly ask that they are returned to school (along with the yellow/purple reading record) every **Tuesday**, so your child can choose a new book. Books will **not** be changed any other day of the week and new books will not be issued if they are not returned to school.

#### White Rose Maths

Nursery children will continue to follow the White Rose Maths scheme. We are focusing on counting beyond 10, counting out an amount from a group of 5 objects, showing 1, 2, and 3 on our fingers. We will look at the properties of a circle, square, triangle and a rectangle. We will also look at heights, identifying taller and shorter.

## **Spring Term Topics**

Our topic for this half term is 'Space'. The children have already thought of some questions they would like to find out the answers to!

We will be learning about Neil Armstrong and the job of an Astronaut, rockets and space vehicles, and we will find out about The Solar System.

Our Talk for Writing book this half term is 'How to catch a star'.

We will be exploring colour mixing and how to make different shades.

We are excited to get started!
