Learning Activities and Assignments -

- 1. <u>Mini Quizzes</u> short multiple choice and free response questions you can answer after each lecture video for Week 1, Week 2 and Week 3 (optional, not graded)
- 2. Reflection Prompts Independent tasks you submit via forms on the M2 website.
- 3. <u>Discussion Posts</u> Shared in your Discord group #assignments channel.
- 4. <u>Peer Discussion</u> Delivered in Discord Meeting Rooms to 2-3 peers.
- 5. **End of Module Assessment** Submitted to Aspire for as a final assessment. Graded.

Time Commitment

Module 2 is five weeks long. You can expect to spend approximately **five hours per week** on your Module 2 assignments. The program is completed virtually with both asynchronous and synchronous components. This module is self-paced, meaning most tasks are completed asynchronously with no hard deadlines. The only hard deadline is the due date for the End of Module 2 Assessment, which is due by **October 7th, 11:59pm ET**
