

CARY VOLUNTEERS

DO:

1. **Introduce yourself to the Chief Judge immediately upon arrival.**
2. **Inquire of the Chief Judge where it would be best for you to position yourself.**
3. **Remember that the Chief Judge is the sworn appointed official in charge of the precinct. It is his/her responsibility to maintain order and guarantee the election process is conducted according to law.**
4. **If you do not want to stand inside the voting facility, bring a card table and chair for you to sit.**
5. **Position yourself inside the voting enclosure.**
6. **Post a sign on your table – “Any questions – ask me”**
7. **Ask the voter entering the polling place if they have questions on marking the IRV ballot but do not impede the path of the voters or stop them.**

DO NOT:

1. **Wear any items indicating political preference**
 2. **Wear clothing, buttons, etc. displaying loyalty to any candidate or proposition**
 3. **Offer to assist voters in the act of voting – the voter must request assistance**
 4. **Give any opinions on IRV**
 5. **Follow the voter to the voting booth**
 6. **Offer to help any of the officials in their duties**
 7. **Represent yourself as a sworn precinct official**
 8. **Touch any official election materials**
 9. **Use any sample ballots to inform the voter how to mark the ballot or use any real candidates names to illustrate the marking of the ballot**
- **If the voter does not stop for questions on completing the ballot but then asks the Registration Table Official or the Ballot Table Official a question, an official or the volunteer can answer the question if it will not slow down the process of other voters in line.**
 - **If the voter has been issued the ballot, starts to mark the ballot, and then has questions, the official should answer the question. If the official cannot answer, the voter should spoil the ballot, go to the volunteer to ask the question, and then get a replacement ballot. Do not allow voters to walk to the door, where the volunteer is positioned, with the ballot.**
