Logline: Two non-binary neurodiverse best friends infiltrate a clandestine corporation experimenting with humanity's worst impulses - to satiate their own hunger for power and adventure.

Content warnings: lack of bodily autonomy via possession, non-consensual off-screen sexual relationships, combat violence, queerphobia
