DIVE MP4 CDs Mac Installation & Tech Solutions

DIVE courses are MP4 videos that play in VLC Player (free download). Technical issues are quickly and easily solved by following the steps below. Please do not contact the retailer.

I. Install VLC Player

- 1. Check for software updates (Apple Icon, About This Mac, Software Update) and install if available.
- 2. Restart computer do this even if you didn't install updates.



- 3. Place the CD in the CD drive. A Finder window should pop up. If not select Finder
- 4. Select "Important: Open Me First".




5. Select Installation



6. Read the EULA and select Agree & Continue.



7. Select the link titled **DIVE Teacher Guide**.




8. Follow the steps on the Teacher Guide. Give a copy of the Student Instructions (or Daily Schedule) and Assignment Chart pages to your student. They should follow these steps for each assignment.

9. Click here to **Download VLC Media Player*** After downloading, you must come back to this page and follow <u>ALL</u> the steps below.

*If you already have VLC, update it, then skip to Watch a Video Lecture below.


- After the download has completed, open your Downloads Folder (Finder, Downloads).
- Double click the file titled vlc__.dmg



Click and drag the orange VLC cone to the Applications folder.




- Wait for the files to copy. When copying is finished, a message will pop up.
- Open Finder, scroll down left menu to DEVICES.
- Click the eject button next to the vlc installer.



II. How to Open & Play a Video Lecture

1. In Finder, scroll down the left menu to Devices then double click the title of the CD.



2. At the top of the Finder window, select the icon with four little squares. This will show only the files on the CD.



3. Double click the **folder** titled DIVE <your course title and edition>




4. Find the video lecture you want to watch. Place your cursor on the title of the video (not the image).



5. To right click On an Apple Magic Trackpad (see image below) and Mac laptops, place your cursor on the lesson and press the trackpad with two fingers.



6. Right click on the video title (not the image). A submenu will pop-up. Select Open With, then VLC.



- 7. Important Note: As John Saxon recommended, Dr. Shormann teaches different example problems than the lesson in the Saxon text. This ensures adequate practice on the new concept. During the DIVE lecture, students should take brief notes and work example problems with Dr. Shormann. Students should not look at the textbook during the lecture. For details, see the <u>DIVE Teacher Guide</u>.
- 8. If you haven't the Teacher Guide, go back to Section 1 Step 7 above.
