School counselors provide short-term, solution-focused services. Sometimes, children need long-term, more intensive therapy from a licensed therapist.

Could my child benefit from individual or family therapy?*

While children are often able to adapt on their own after a critical incident or life stressor, sometimes seeking professional help can be beneficial. These services support resilience by providing tools to cope, reminding children they are not alone, helping identify language to describe their feelings, and sharing with trusted adults.

When any of the following are present, this may indicate a need for a licensed professional therapist:

- Sudden and/or significant changes in behavior
- Sudden and/or significant changes in interests
- Anxious behavior, excessive worrying
- Isolation or avoidance of friends or family
- Extreme sadness

- Decline in academic performance
- Sudden or rapid changes in mood
- Self-injurious behaviors
- Harmful acts to self or other children
- Thoughts of suicide (verbal, artwork, writing)
