1. About this Document

1.1 Purpose

The Documentation describes the Services, the user instructions for the Services, and the Service Standards, as of **14th of August**, **2023**.

2. Description of the Services

2.1 What is Cadmus?

Cadmus is an online assessment platform accessed through the LMS. It enables teachers to create written assessment tasks for students to complete. Cadmus is designed to simplify the process of delivering high-quality assessment experiences to students while helping them learn and develop academic skills.

Cadmus is made up of two environments accessed through the LMS:

- Cadmus Teacher Environment
- Cadmus Student Environment

2.1.1 Cadmus Teacher Environment

In the <u>Teacher Environment</u>, you can:

- create and release assessment instructions to students through the web-based text editor
- attach files and web links as resources for assessments
- manage draft and final submissions, view similarity scores, and access marking through the in-built class list
- use Turnitin Feedback Studio or Canvas SpeedGrader to provide feedback
- automatically sync grades to the LMS Grade Centre

2.1.2 Cadmus Student Environment

In the Student Environment, students can:

- access assessment instructions and resources released by teachers
- take notes and plan assessments in a designated space

- write their submission in the web-based text editor
- access context-specific academic skills information and curated university guides as they work
- benefit from educative scaffolds and behavioural nudges to encourage academic best practices (e.g. paraphrasing and citing)
- submit drafts and finals
- review similarity reports through the Cadmus-Turnitin integration
- access grades and feedback in Turnitin Feedback Studio once marking is completed

The university will have access to detailed reporting, enabling more oversight of assessment practices across the university. This includes:

• Learning Analytics and Reporting (unit-, school-, faculty- and university-level)

2.2 Technical Requirements

Cadmus is a **web application**, meaning it can only run within a **web browser** environment.

2.2.1 Supported Browsers

Cadmus isn't supported on every browser. Some browsers, particularly older ones, only support some of the functionality required for Cadmus.

For peace of mind, we recommend switching to one of the supported browsers listed below and updating to the latest version:

- Chrome
- Firefox
- Safari
- Microsoft Edge

For the best experience, we recommend using **Chrome**.

2.2.2 Mobile Browsers

Cadmus was designed for computers and hasn't been thoroughly tested on mobile devices (phones, tablets, iPads etc.) yet. Please stick to accessing Cadmus from a laptop or desktop.
