Each teacher will document any infractions of the above rules accumulated during each nine week period. A <u>running total of infractions</u> will be kept for all students. To encourage students to modify their behavior, the following consequences will be in place.

When a student:

- Accumulates 3 infractions—Parental contact
- Accumulates 6 infractions—Referral to I.S.S.P.

Each infraction will be recorded in the student's agenda. After the initial referral the process will start over.

Please <u>check the agenda daily</u> to keep up with your child's progress. In addition, severe infractions will be dealt with immediately on an individual basis.
