Location and Venue Information

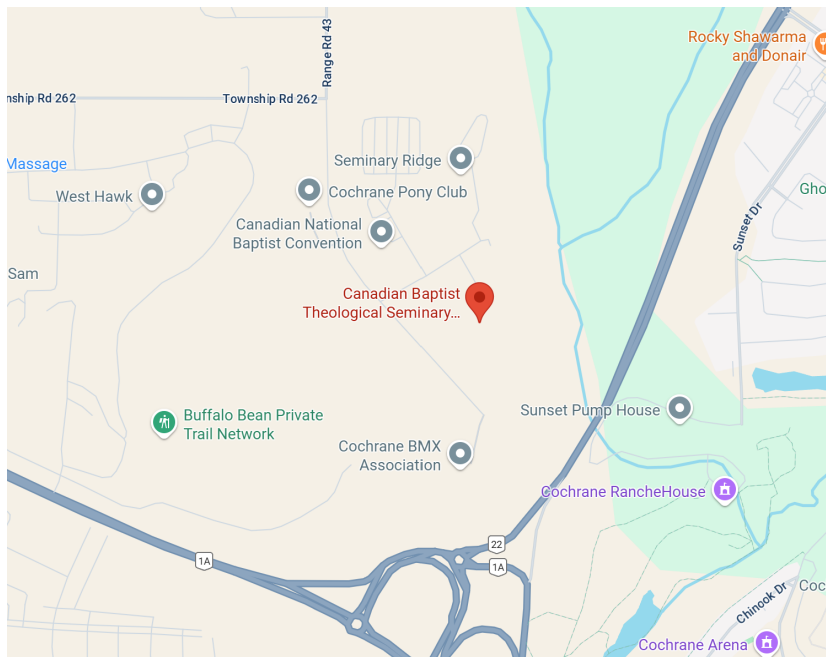
We will once again be hosting our race at the

Parking

There is lots of parking at the Seminary with overflow parking just North of the Seminary. There will be parking marshalls to direct you to the appropriate lot.



Categories

Categories for licensed riders are as below. New cross racers will compete in the cyclocross category corresponding to their respective Road or Mountain Bike category, whichever is higher. Riders with a Single Event License (SEL) are restricted to the category indicated.

All riders will be called up for the start of each race and must arrive 10 minutes before the start of their race.

Course Pre-riding

The course will be open for official pre-ride as indicated in the above.

There are additional small-time gaps after each race, but all pre-riding between races is subject to Cycling Alberta Commissaire approval. Do not ride the course when other categories are racing. Please only enter the course from the Finish Area to do any pre-riding.

Pit Area

The race will have a dual-entry pit area where riders can change wheels or bicycles that will be marked with yellow tape. Make sure you label your stuff and collect it after your race. Deadgoat will not be held responsible for anything lost or stolen.

Chip timing

We will be using the Zone4 chip timing system.

Racers will pick up their timing chips at the race site. It must be placed on your bicycle and returned immediately after your race. Lost chips have a \$75 fee.

Kids race

We will be having a kids race on a short track course, bring your bikes and a helmet and expect to have fun. sweet prizes too. All ages welcome.

There will be a waiver to sign before the race so please make sure you arrive at least 15

minutes before the race starts to register your child.

Awards

Podium presentation will be 15min after the conclusion of each race.

Podium presentation will be for the top 3 riders in each category.

License Information

All participants must have either a current CA or UCI race license. For those who don't have a license, Single Event Licenses may be purchased for \$20 on Zone 4 during registration.

License check: Each rider must present their license to the ABA Race secretary no later than 15 minutes prior to each respective start.

Body Numbers, License Check & Call-up

Your Cycling Alberta cyclocross numbers are yours for the season - 2 upper arm numbers and 1 body number. These will be provided by the ABA at your first race.

*Upper arm numbers: placed on the upper forearm, facing forward so the officials can see them.

*Body number: placed in the middle of your lower back.

***Bring your own pins.**



All riders will be called up for the start of each race and must arrive 5 minutes before start of race.

Bikes, Equipment & Rules

This event will be run in accordance with ABA/CCC/UCI Cycling regulations. Riders are responsible for knowing and understanding these regulations.

The ABA complies with and fully supports the UCI anti-doping regulations, the clauses of the World Anti-doping Code and its international Standards to which the UCI anti-doping regulation refer and to the anti-doping regulations of other competent bodies as per the regulations of the

UCI.

Elite Men, Expert Men and Open Women and Sport Men racers may only ride cyclocross bikes. Novice Men and Sport Women Racers can use cyclocross or mountain bikes. Competitors must always wear an approved helmet while racing and riding around the grounds. Commissaires only confirm that bikes conform to the Regulations; there is no liability for the condition of the bike. Also, the CCC does not approve helmets. Commissaires ensure that a) the helmet is intended for cycling use; and b) the helmet has been approved by some regulatory body. The act of handing out food or drinks is not allowed during cyclo-cross races (there is no Feed Zone). Nevertheless, a rider may keep and use food or drinks which they carry on their bikes or in their outfits.
