<https://elevenlabs.io/> - This will allow you to use their voices, or CLONE your own voices. You could clone anyone and the system will get better, and LEARN what you are trying to achieve. What if you want your morning show to read a bunch of keywords? If you have them cloned- you just saved your AM show time, and YOU don't have to hunt them down to record 300 keywords for a contest. What if your VO person is ok with you using? If something newsworthy happens on a weekend and you need your voice person on the fly... to get something on the air immediately... you have that opportunity.
