Team representative's signature is required on the Travel/Consent/Medical/Payment form to show that you have read and will follow this code.

As a Team Member, at all times I will:

- Co-operate with my team manager, team mates and opponents.

Parent/Spectator Code of Conduct

Parent's signature is required **on the Travel/Consent/Medical/Payment form to indicate you have read and agree to comply with the following code of conduct.**

- Remember, children are involved in organised sport for their enjoyment.
- Encourage your child to always play by the rules.
- Encourage children to participate, please do not force them.
- Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- Encourage children always to play according to the rule and to settle disagreements without resorting to hostility or violence.
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- Remember that children learn best by example. Appreciate good performances and skilful plays by all participants.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Respect officials' decision and teach children to do likewise.
- Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
