  built that in a week, I'm sure it was a lot longer time spent conceptualizing it and making
  the components.
- The day done one of our members was talking to Goblendust (Scott) about what his plans where and he and Bounce Bounce were going to go after The Kwanga Kate Gadget Cache GC8DQ55 We had actually tried to go there Wed Night after we did a nearby gadget cache. When we got there before GeoMonkeyTiger! (Matt) And MOTgeo (Graham) (were already there, had been working for 1hr 20mins and explained that to get the full experience we should come back (i.e. we got rejected politely... which was good.) GearGuru, Genomac1, Burnside were also invited along and with my crew (GBs, Linda#1, Seasquirel, Ateamvallejo, Winston4ever, and BibleManRick) we had 12 people working planning on getting there before the Heave Ho Off You go event and try it out.
