
Stop CDCR Sexual Abuse - Advocacy Toolkit



TAKE ACTION TO SUPPORT INCARCERATED SURVIVORS!

The Guardian published a series of <u>investigative reports</u> by Sam Levin that documents the crisis of sexual assault in California prisons (<u>part 1</u>, <u>part 2</u>, <u>part 3</u>). Systemic sexual violence exists in prisons across the U.S.

Sexual violence at the hands of prison guards is institutional, horrifying, and an inherent part of prison systems and culture.

How to Help


