



German NCEA Level 2

Course Description:

During this course we will read about and discuss various topics including current issues relating to young people, their relationships and friendships, leisure activities as well as health and environmental issues in NZ and German speaking countries. Students will use the target language effectively to express their ideas and opinions and negotiate meaning. We will compare and contrast similarities and differences between NZ and German speaking countries.

This course consists of three internal assessments (2.3 interaction is optional) and two external assessments. **A total of 24 credits will be offered.**
