The ECC exists for teams to consider each student as a whole so that they can gain the skills needed to empower them to reach their full potential. The ECC is essential to providing a free and appropriate education for all students.

Our goal

Every student who is served by IESBVI will have a team who collaboratively embeds intentional, consistent, prioritized ECC instruction, driven by assessment.

To reach our goals

- · We will collaborate and provide ways to support a student with a visual impairment in their classroom by embedding ECC within routines of the school day and the school environment.
- · We will gather input from and collaborate with all team members, including the student, to screen and prioritize student needs in the ECC.
- · We will use the ECC screener to determine appropriate ECC assessments in areas of need.
- · We will educate teams on what is included within the ECC.
- · We will create intentional lessons (and goals) focused on the prioritized ECC areas of need.
- · We will provide a challenging, rigorous and developmentally appropriate curriculum, which addresses individual student needs.
