Please remember that I grade based on your mastery of the standards! **What is MOST important is whether or not you learn the skill or content, not when or how you learn it.**

So for each Key Concept you get a study guide, we learn about it through lectures, readings and activities, you get some practice quizzes and tests, and then you assess with a formal quiz. That assessment is scored on a 0-4 scale and that is the score in the gradebook. **Please remember to IGNORE the percentages in Student Connect.** The letter grades align with this scoring as seen below.
