Preparedness: Arrives on time with all materials (binder, book, red pen, dark pen, paper, charged Chromebook, etc.). Is ready to attempt an answer when called upon and is able to field questions confidently and logically. All assignments are totally complete.
Warm-up: Immediately takes out HW, book, red pen, dark pen, and paper. Without prompting, individually attempts the assignment. Quietly finishes before class corrections are made. Work is thorough, neat, and organized. Thoughtfully corrects everything with a red pen. If applicable, answers are circled, boxed, bolded, or highlighted. Quietly studies if finished early. Actively works with partner when prompted.
Correction Process: Accurately corrects all written work. Corrects in a neat, thoughtful, and organized manner. Written corrections are done in red pen. Makes use of both teacher & classmate input for self correction.
Group/Class Work: Engaged in class and contributes positively to progress. Respectful of contributions made by others. Maintains a positive attitude even when faced with challenging material. Supportive of classmates. On task.
Personal Responsibility for Learning: Asks questions to clarify understanding when necessary. Seeks means for extra help when needed. Does appropriate practice and review at home. Takes advantage of extra resources to improve understanding.
Quality of Failure: Challenges self to present ideas or answers when not confident in the solution. Volunteers to answer questions when unsure of correctness. Willing to offer a thought or explanation regardless of correctness. Maintains a positive attitude to learn from mistakes.
Independence: On task during pair and group activities the entire time and is ready when called upon. Actively contributes to group or pair work. Consistently follows class procedures and rules.
Quality of Participation: Attempts to answer open-ended questions in class discussion. Elaborates on answers beyond minimum level. Attempts to communicate more complex ideas. Actively participates in all class activities and is a willing volunteer. Always communicates in a respectful manner.
Listening: Actively listens to the teacher and fellow student(s). Follows directions. After listening to class activities, responds to comprehension questions.
Communication: Tries to employ language learned in class. Makes an attempt to use level appropriate tense, word choice, subject-verb and noun-adjective agreement. Student frequently self-corrects.
